We continue to work closely with the Commission of Fine Arts Staff to refine and make the final minute-type detail edits on and within the memorial footprint. At the same time, the stone (granite) quarried in Brazil has been received in Carrara, Italy, for the fabrication and then the carving process. This is a huge logistical accomplishment, and we are extremely excited as our team starts the creative process on what we believe will be an inspiring and timeless commemorative work.

Our goal back here in the U.S. is to complete the "Construction Permitting" process and hopefully receive our construction permit from the National Park Service sometime in early 2024, with our ultimate memorial completion goal being sometime in 2025.
